History for praxis

The course "Baltic Experiences" mainly focuses on the territories which nowadays belong to Denmark, Estonia, Finland, the North German federal states of Hamburg, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern and Schleswig-Holstein, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, the three Polish voivodships bordering on the Baltic Sea, North Western Russia (including the Kaliningrad region) and Sweden.

The aim of the course is not only to provide you with a historical overview about social and cultural developments, but also enable you with intercultural communication skills. You are capable of a qualified judgment on possible opinion(s) of future business and/or conversation partners. A subsequent aim is to raise awareness about the relative value of your very own historical view. With intensive international communication and exchange, you develop strategies towards a diplomatic and sensitive behaviour in intercultural situations.

Course progression: 100% online

The continuing education courses incl. the examination take place 100% online - via the Internet - with an international student group. You meet students with different occupational focuses and experiences. Group work via the Internet afford an intersectional exchange.
